As the elected representatives of the Madison School District community the Madison Board of Education is responsible for the education of 1,500+ students, manages a \$13.5 million budget, and employs nearly 190 staff members. Serving as a school board member is clearly a very significant responsibility. Madison is, indeed, fortunate to have seven dedicated and committed Board members that do their very best to fulfill the District Vision of "Developing individual excellence through rigorous academics, innovative technology, and personal attention". Thanks to each of you for your service to our youth.
- II. The Wayne RESA (the Wayne County equivalent of the LISD) has produced an 11 minute video on the new Michigan Department of Education "Cut Scores" for the MEAP and MME tests. I would like to have you view this video during our meeting. I know you will find it informative. We have received the data from the most recent MEAP tests, but that information is still embargoed. We will plan to review the data with you at the February meeting.
- III. The LISD is once again requesting that each local Board of Education appoint a delegate to their annual budget hearing. The first meeting is February 16th at 6:00 p.m. at the ESC; dinner will be provided. There will be a follow up meeting on April 26th. It would be possible for two different Board members to attend the two meetings.
- IV. Even though we will not be electing Board members until November we still need to renew our millage this May. You will need to pass a resolution at this meeting calling for an election to be held in May. If we continue our past practice we would renew our millage annually. You could choose to renew for two years or more, but you will risk a Headlee rollback after the first year. I think I have previously mentioned how I feel about the stupidity of this new consolidated election legislation. The turnout in May will be dismal, but the cost will be about the same as last May when we both renewed the millage and elected Board members.
- V. The day after Christmas Kyle, Mark, Brad, Nate, and I walked the woods behind the football field and reviewed the trees that were marked by a logging company for removal. I initially had some concerns when I learned 81 trees had been marked for removal. After walking the woods I do not believe any of us on the committee any longer have those concerns. There are literally thousands of trees in the woods and it really needs to have some of the larger trees removed to open up the canopy so other trees can develop. The

committee decided to ask two other companies to also check out the woods, provide us with their recommendation on trees that should be removed, and give us a bid. The three companies and their bids are:

Tri County Logging - 81 trees - \$10,800

Cutting Edge Logging - 118 trees - \$13,000 - \$15,000

Post Hardwoods - 107 trees - \$16,839

The high bidder, Post Hardwoods, is from Hamilton MI. When I refer to the high bidder I am not just looking at the total price, but also a per tree price. Their per tree price is \$157.37, Tri County is \$133.33, and Cutting Edged is \$110.16 -\$127.11. We do know one other local person that Post Hardwoods has done logging for. The person highly recommends them.

VI. I would like to have some discussion with you at this meeting concerning merit or performance pay. As you are well aware, all of our employees had their wages frozen for the 2011-12 school year. You are also aware that legislation was approved in 2010 that required teacher "compensation and additional compensation" to be based on performance. When we negotiated with the teachers this summer I indicated that I would be recommending the Board designate an amount of money to be split up between the teachers that are deemed to be "effective" or "highly effective" via our new evaluation instrument. My initial thinking was that a lump sum amount would be designated by the Board for this purpose and then that sum of money would be divided equally between the teachers that were rated effective or highly effective. I have since slightly revised my thinking on the approach that should be taken to award the performance stipends. A significant part of a teacher's evaluation has to be based on student achievement and various measurements have been established to determine student achievement. One of the measurements for the high school teachers is the ACT exam and the results of that exam are not available until August. If we wait for those results, and then divide up the total amount of money designated for performance, none of our teachers could receive their performance stipend until mid to late August. I know they would appreciate receiving the stipend sooner than that if possible. Instead of designating a total amount of money to be divided up we could establish an individual amount to be awarded per teacher for any teacher rated effective or highly effective. As an example, if the Board designated a total of \$96,000 for performance stipends that would equate to \$1,000 per teacher if each of our 96 teachers qualified for the stipend. Or, you could simply designate a performance stipend of \$1,000 per each full time teacher that is rated effective or highly effective. I am recommending the second approach and an amount of \$1,000 per full time teacher. If the teachers had received their increments this past year (which they did not) the increments would have cost about \$9,000 more than what the performance stipends would total if every teacher qualifies for the stipend. This process certainly complies with the legal requirements to base additional compensation on performance, and, many would argue, is a much

better model than simply awarding additional compensation based on someone working here a year longer.

I would envision the other 14 non-teachers that are members of the professional staff that are deemed effective or highly effective receiving the same performance stipend as the teachers.

In the past the Board has always made a priority of treating all of our employees fairly. I think that priority still needs to be in effect when merit pay is considered. That is not to say that other employees should receive merit pay equal to what the teachers receive, but they should be considered for merit pay based on their job responsibilities, the fulfillment of those responsibilities, attendance, work ethic, etc. After discussing this concept with the administrative team I am recommending that members of the support staff deemed to be effective or highly effective be awarded the equivalent of an average of two to three days compensation equated for the number of hours that they actually work. As an example, the average wage of the food service employees is \$11.28 per hour. Under this proposal each employee would receive \$11.28 x the number of hours they typically work per day x 2. A six hour per day cook would receive $11.28 \times 6 \times 2 = 135.36$. A 3 hour per day cook would receive half that amount. The total per diem cost for all of our support staff members is \$5,602. If all of the support staff qualified for the performance stipend (and they will not all qualify), support staff performance stipends equivalent to two days pay would be \$11,204. Three days would be \$16,806.

Those of us that are retired/rehired, and that are being paid the maximum allowable salary, would not receive a performance stipend.

- VII. We are continuing to make progress on satisfying the "Best Practice" requirements for the additional \$100 per student funding. Three of the practices have been verified to the State. The fourth is in progress, but it is very time consuming to complete. Dawn Opsal began working on the requirement to obtain bids for a support service during the holiday break. There are about 70 pages of guidelines to work through, and Dawn is making progress on it. As soon as that step is complete you will be asked to pass the required resolution so we can apply for the additional funding.
- VIII. I have been working on our Board policy revision. I had a half day work session on December 15th with the NEOLA representative; two more half day sessions are scheduled in February. At this point I have read through and worked on five of the ten sections of the policy manual. Not the most exciting reading, but it is certainly important. NEOLA is definitely providing the expertise and assistance that I was expecting when we agreed to work with them on this project.
 - IX. The second week of January the Adrian Morning Rotary Club (that Dawn and

I are members of) began providing the food for our Interact students to prepare weekend snack packs for 40 of our low income students. Each snack pack includes five healthy snacks that will be sent home discretely each Friday afternoon through the end of the school year with 40 students identified by our elementary staff in need of this assistance. Rotary started this project this past September in one of the Adrian elementary schools and have now expanded it to Madison and a second Adrian elementary building.

- X. The county superintendents will have their regular monthly meeting on Friday, January 13th. Part of that agenda will be follow up discussion on the December 15th county wide meeting to discuss collaboration, advertising, etc. On December 16th I emailed all of the county superintendents with a couple of suggestions on how I thought we might be able to move forward with more collaborative advertising. Hopefully our January 13th discussion will be productive. I will update you at your meeting.
- XI. The day of your meeting most of the county schools will be involved in a county-wide professional development program coordinated by the LISD. Ten of the sessions will be held at Madison. One of the sessions we have asked all of our staff to attend is a half day presentation from Dr. Anthony Muhammad on school culture. I have not had the privilege of hearing Dr. Muhammad speak in the past, but I have read some of his work. Linda and Nate have heard him speak. We believe he has an important message that all of us need to reflect on.
- XII. Dave Siler informs me that he will be driving the Performing Arts Center blueprints to Lansing on January 17th. It has taken far too long to get to this point in the project, but we are getting there. I was saddened to learn of Bob Soller's passing. Prior to becoming ill Bob consulted with us on this project and provided some very valuable insight. I suspect it might well have been the last project that he provided assistance on. He was a very gifted community treasure.
- XIII. Last week I emailed both Rep. Jenkins and Sen. Caswell with questions about PA 152 the legislation establishing the insurance hard CAP or the 80/20 insurance premium share. After reading the law several times I was left with a question about when it would impact our maintenance and custodial employees. Their contract expires June 30, 2012 and the most common interpretation of the law is that they would be impacted by the legislation as of July 1, 2012. However, I also believe it is possible to read the law in a manner that says they would not be impacted until January 2013 when their new insurance year starts. I contacted Rep. Jenkins and Sen. Caswell recently to ask that they provide clarification. Sen. Caswell's aid called me back just a couple of hours after he received my email and said I had a very interesting question. He also thought the law could be read both ways and promised to get clarification for me. He called back on January 10th and told

me PA 152 would impact the custodians as of July 1, 2012. On January 11th I received a letter from Rep. Jenkins which was dated January 10th. Her letter informed me that the "House Majority Policy Office" had informed her that "the maintenance and custodial employees are subject to the law at the beginning of their medical benefit plan year – January 1, 2013".

After I received Rep. Jenkins response I shared it with Sen. Caswell. His aide called me back a couple of hours later. He had called the person in the House Majority Policy Office that Rep. Jenkins talked to. (It was a person he had previously worked with and knew very well.) She assures him her interpretation is correct. Of course he is still getting a conflicting interpretation from the Senate policy folks.

I know somehow this will get figured out, but it is just one more example of how much time we waste trying to implement things Lansing imposes on us. It is just wonderful that legislators pass legislation and really don't understand what it means and, worse yet, can't even figure out what it means months after they passed it. Please understand, I am not specifically being critical of Rep. Jenkins and Sen. Caswell (I actually deeply appreciate their efforts to answer my questions), but I am certainly critical of a legislature that time and again does not know what they are doing. Reminds me of the old saying, "there are two things you never want to watch being made, laws and sausage".

We did have four secretaries that were impacted by the law as of this past January 1st. They are secretaries that do not have contracts, but do use our HSA health insurance. I have a lot of empathy for these ladies. They have been part of the employee group that includes secretaries, administrators, and maintenance and custodial employees that having been saving the District a significant amount of money for the past 5 years by utilizing the HSA insurance coverage. The other administrators certainly shared my concern for these four ladies. A plan was voluntarily agreed to by 11 administrators that reduced the average payment for the four secretaries from \$117.82/month to \$39/month. The administrators are contributing between \$19/month to \$36.71/month depending on their salary range. It says a lot about the folks we have working here when they recognize something is not right and take action to correct it.

- XIV. I was extremely disappointed to learn of the closing of the Sears store. What a blow to our local economy. The departure of that major mall tenant will also have a significant impact on our taxable values.
- XV. It could end any day, but our weather thus far this winter has done wonders for our heat bills and has certainly made transportation much less stressful.
- XVI. The semi-annual State Revenue Estimating Conference is scheduled for this Friday, January 13th. It is very clear that the State has significantly more

revenue in both the General Fund and the School Aid Fund than was anticipated at the May 2011 Revenue Estimating Conference. What is not at all clear is how much, if any of that money will be used to provide additional support for K-12 public education. I will be in Detroit in early February for the MASA mid-winter conference where I know school finance will be one of the topics of discussion.

Baby Talk: Tuesdays 8:30-9:30 – Easy finger plays and songs and a short play time are the focus of this group. Age 5 and Under: Wednesdays 9:30-10:50 and Thursdays 2:00-3:20 – Winter theme this month along with "Everyday Living" activities like pouring, scooping, tweezing, twisting etc., all to enhance fine motor muscle development for future writing skills is the focus of these two groups. They also attend library and have gym time once a month. Kindergarten Readiness: Fridays 9:30-10:50 – Winter theme this month and "Everyday Living" activities as listed above to enhance fine motor muscle development for future writing skills, Phonics Dance chants, and numeration is the focus of this group. They also attend library and have gym time once a month. Currently 34 children attend the various Play Groups offered throughout the week; 4 new families registered this month. The Play Group families receive weekly email newsletters regarding the weekly curriculum schedule and community events. They also receive newsletters from the Family Education Network and Scholastic Family. Scholastic book orders are placed monthly. The Clothing Bank remains active with 9 pieces of clothing distributed this month. A used small toddler size Mickey Mouse tricycle was purchased with funds received from the Resource Room Mom to Mom sale. It will be used for gym time. Steve Cox delivered 4 new shelving units to the Play Group classroom right after Christmas break. They are a welcome addition to the environment providing ample space to place activities for the children to use.

*Family Resource Room:

<u>Love and Logic</u>: The winter Love and Logic workshop ended January 5 with 17 in attendance. Two new workshops have been scheduled. 1) February 22, 29, March 7, 14, 21. 1:30 – 3:25 p.m. in the Board Room. Childcare environment to be determined. Light snacks and a prize each week will be provided by LISD. 2) February 23, March 1, 8, 15, 22. 6:30-8:00 p.m. in the H.S. Library with childcare in the Cafetorium. Joe Baker will facilitate both workshops. Flyers for registration will be made available to the community the last week of January.

<u>Team Time:</u> Working with 2 groups of third graders and 2 groups of first graders Monday through Thursday.

<u>WLEN and The Daily Telegram:</u> Madison School District events are emailed for submission weekly on Wednesday afternoons.
