#### Superintendent's Report

March 21, 2016

#### I. County Common Calendar Survey (Information Item)

I included data from the recent County Common Calendar Survey in the Board Packet. It was determined that there was not enough support to move forward with a waiver to potentially begin school prior to Labor Day. There was support to begin work to construct a county-wide calendar where the 11 school districts and the LISD would align as much of the school calendar as possible. The 2016-17 school year will be the first year that school districts are required to have at least 180 days of instruction. Districts having a consistent amount of school days may help as planning occurs to try and coordinate common school days, breaks, and professional development days.

On a related note, the lack of support to begin school prior to Labor Day communicated a strong message that expansion of Balanced School Year (BSY) programs offered through other schools within Lenawee County will not likely occur at any point soon. It is widely recognized that in order to offer BSY at the secondary level, efforts would almost certainly have to occur for all students, rather than for a group of students. For instance a "school within a school" such as what we have at the elementary would be very difficult at the secondary and would most likely have to occur with all schools county-wide. Unlike at the elementary where whole classes can be on one schedule or the other, aspects of teacher certification and the variety of courses at the secondary level pose a significant challenge to offer BSY at the middle and high school. In addition, county-wide special education and career and technical education programs follow a schedule based on the traditional school year.

We will enter the third year of Madison's Balanced School Year this fall. This is the final year the three-year waiver granted to Madison to allow the BSY to begin prior to Labor Day. A comprehensive study of specific aspects of the BSY program will occur throughout this fall to determine whether or not to apply for another waiver. Applying to MDE for another waiver would have to occur in order to continue the BSY educational option at Madison beyond the 2016-17 school year. We will take a look at how enrollment has changed -- increased, decreased or stayed the same --over the three school years since the program began. Analysis will also include a comparison of student achievement, student discipline, and student attendance data between students on the BSY and TSY. In addition we will look at the cost to operate the BSY program for the time school is in session beyond the regular school year. After two years operating the BSY we are now able to look at additional costs related to areas such as transportation and food service. The LISD has been able to assist to provide itinerant staff for students with special needs participating with the BSY. However, we will have to communicate with the LISD to see how this support has affected the efficiency and effectiveness of their operations as well. It has indeed

been a challenge for Nate and Linda to balance aspects such as class size across an entire grade level operating the two different schedules. Balancing specials classes while maintaining a specific number of instructional days and providing services to students with specific needs has at times also been difficult to achieve. On the other hand, we have heard very positive comments from many of the students, parents, and teachers who have chosen to experience the BSY program.

#### II. May 3<sup>rd</sup> Election (Information Item)

I ask that you do what you can to educate your family members, friends, and neighbors about the two millage items pertaining to Madison Schools placed on the May 3<sup>rd</sup> ballot for residents of Madison School District. The 18 mill operational renewal is not levied on a person's primary residency, only on second homes, and commercial and industrial property. The additional 0.25 mill Building and Site request would cost a typical home owner (\$100,000 home with a \$50,000 taxable value) approximately \$1.00 a month or \$12.00 per year. Potential projects to maintain and improve the current facility are outlined on the Website for individuals to review. I have attached a proof of the ballot in the Board Packet as it will appear for voters May 3<sup>rd</sup>.

#### III. School of Choice (SOC) for 2016-17 (Action Item)

The Board is asked at this time each year to approve SOC openings per building and grade level for the upcoming school year. Based on current and projected student counts I recommend the Board approve SOC open to all grades as "unlimited" except 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> where we would open SOC with a "minimum 2 students".

#### IV. Winter Athletics (Action Item)

Kris's Athletic Director Board Report is included in your packet, however, I want to extend my congratulations to the teams and individuals who attained extraordinary accomplishments this season. I recommend the Board adopt a resolution acknowledging the accomplishments of teams and individuals who represented Madison in remarkable fashion throughout the winter sport season.

#### V. LISD Budget Review (Information Item)

Board member representatives are invited to the LISD Budget Review Meeting Thursday, April 21, 2016 to be held at the LISD TECH Center starting at 6:00 p.m. I appreciate Mark and Nancy joining me for the February 18<sup>th</sup> LISD Budget Planning Meeting. Mark, Nancy, and all Madison board members are welcome to join me for the upcoming review. Please let me know if you wish to attend and I will RSVP those interested in attending. Dinner will be served.

### VI. Strategic Five-Year Facility Maintenance Plan "2020 Vision" (Information Item)

I am pleased to let you know that an additional investment aligned with the Guiding Principles outlined below has been achieved and hopefully will continue. LED light fixtures have been installed in the HS/MS Media Center and throughout the middle

school hallways. The fixtures look fantastic, use approximately one-quarter of the energy of previous light fixtures lowering unnecessary expenses, and produce a quality light throughout these areas. I am hopeful that this initiative can continue throughout the entire campus.

Madison School District is committed to a Five-Year Strategic Facility Maintenance Plan, a "2020 Vision" that will:

- ▶ provide a progressive, innovative, and safe learning environment to enhance student instruction and performance.
- ▶ allow the District to function in the most efficient and cost-effective manner possible.
- ▶ utilize technology to manage aspects of the facility to lower unnecessary expenses.
- ▶ improve branding and marketability of the District through progressive, innovative, yet cost-effective enhancements.
