Dear Parent/Guardian:

_____ did not earn credit in one or more required classes this past school year; therefore he/she needs to enroll in summer school to stay on track with his/her current graduation class.

Credit recovery courses will be completed on the computer utilizing a web-based program, Edgenuity (formally known as E2020). **Classes will begin on Monday, July 9th and end on Friday, August 17th. Students may complete as many courses as they wish during this period for a one-time, flat fee of \$70.** Payment for summer school can be made on myschoolbucks.com. All coursework is administered online and students will be required to complete 40% - 60% of the daily assignments outside of the classroom setting. In order to complete coursework, students will need access to the internet beyond the designated time spent in the class setting. **Students must take and pass all final exams in the presence of the instructor, Ms. Lora Stricklen, in order to earn credit.**

The Edgenuity program is a self-paced curriculum. Therefore, students who successfully complete their coursework prior to August 17th may choose to enroll in a second course or will be released early from the Summer School Program.

The summer school daily schedule will be 8:30am – 11:30am (Monday- Friday). Students will be provided transportation, however, space is limited to the first 50 students that sign up on a first come, first serve basis.
