

Dear Parent/Guardian:

_____ did not earn credit in one or more required classes this past school year; therefore he/she needs to enroll in summer school to stay on track with his/her current graduation class. Students are registered for a total of 18 graded trimester courses each school year. A student must pass a minimum of 14 trimester courses to earn promotion to the next grade level. A student that fails three trimesters of any core class (Language Arts, Math, Science, or Social Studies), regardless of the number of trimester courses passed, will be required to pass a minimum of one summer school class to earn promotion. To determine a middle level student's status, please refer to the retention policy listed in the handbook on page 34. Based on this policy one can determine if a middle level student will be promoted, required to pass one course in summer school, required to pass two courses in summer school, or will be retained. The expectations outlined in this policy will be the standards used to determine student promotion.

Credit recovery courses will be completed on the computer utilizing a web-based program, Edgenuity (formally known as E2020). Classes will begin on Monday, July 9th and end on Friday, August 17th. Students may complete as many courses as they wish during this period for a one-time, flat fee of \$70. All coursework is administered online and students will be required to complete 40% - 60% of the daily assignments outside of the classroom setting. In order to complete coursework, students will need access to the internet beyond the designated time spent in the class setting. Students must take and pass all final exams in the presence of the instructor, Mrs. Lora Stricklen, in order to earn credit.

The Edgenuity program is a self-paced curriculum. Therefore, students who successfully complete their coursework prior to August 15th may choose to enroll in a second course or will be released early from the Summer School Program.

The summer school daily schedule will be 8:30am – 11:30am (Monday- Friday). District resident students will be provided transportation, however, space is limited to the first 50 students that sign up on a first come, first serve basis.
