

Early Elementary Suggested School Supply List

Your child's assigned teacher will also send a separate letter before school begins letting you know if there is anything else your child will need for his or her specific class room.

KINDERGARTEN

1. 2-4 boxes of crayons, 24-count
2. 2 large boxes of facial tissue
3. 12 glue sticks
4. Backpack (regular size; no wheels)
5. 3 spiral notebooks
6. Dry Erase Markers (at least 4; Expo brand recommended)
7. Disinfectant wipes
8. Paper towels

FIRST GRADE

1. 2 boxes of crayons (24 count, Crayola preferred)
2. 3 large boxes of facial tissue
3. 2 Composition notebook
4. 1 plastic pencil box (5.5" x 8.5")
5. 6-8 glue sticks
6. Scissors (small, Fiskars work best)
7. Large erasers
8. 2 boxes of Ziploc bags (1 sandwich and 1 gallon size)
9. 1 package of baby wipes (refill packs are fine)
10. Backpack
11. Sandwich sized plastic bags
12. Dry erase markers (at least 4)
13. 1 roll of paper towels
14. 1 container of disinfectant wipes
15. 1 package of napkins
16. Water bottle

SECOND GRADE

1. 8-10 glue sticks
2. 2 boxes of 24 pack crayons (preferably Crayola)
3. 1 box of thin or thick Crayola markers
4. 3-4 large erasers

Second Grade, cont'd.

5. Backpack (no wheels please; will not fit in locker- labeled with student's name)
6. Thin Dry Erase Markers (at least 4- labeled with student's name)
7. 3 Composition Notebook (non-spiral, any pattern or picture- labeled with student's name)
8. 1 Spiral Notebook (labeled with student's name)
9. 1 zippered pencil pouch (labeled with student's name)
10. 1 Set of Headphones or Ear Buds (labeled with student's name)
11. 3 boxes of Kleenex
12. 2 Package of Baby Wipes (refills are fine)
13. 1 container of disinfectant wipes
14. Paper Towels
15. 1 hand soap
16. 1 hand sanitizer
17. 1 box of Gallon Size Ziploc Bags
18. 1 box of Sandwich or Quart Size Ziploc Bags
19. Water bottle

THIRD GRADE

1. Gym shoes to keep in locker
2. Crayons (16 or 24-count), 3 boxes
3. 4 spiral notebooks (red, blue, yellow, black)
4. 3 large boxes of tissue
5. 6 large glue sticks
6. Small pair of Fiskars scissors
7. Pencil box
8. Pencil top erasers, 1 box
9. 2 large erasers
10. 4 solid color folders, 2-pocket (red, blue, yellow, black)
11. 1 (1 inch), 3-ring binder
12. Water bottle
13. Backpack (no wheels, must fit in lockers)
14. 1 pack of black dry erase markers (at least 3 markers)
15. Colored pencils, 3 boxes

Consumable Supplies*: Hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, sandwich Ziploc bags, paper towels, hand soap.
PLEASE DO NOT BRING: Trapper Keepers or zippered notebooks, rulers, markers, pens, oversized pencils or mechanical pencils.

13. Scissors
14. Post-its
15. Index Cards (3x5)
16. Sanitizing Wipes (x2)
17. Hand Sanitizer (x2)
18. Facial Tissues (2 boxes)
19. Ziploc Bags
20. 1 Pack of pastel colored copy paper (pink, green, or yellow)
21. 3 black Sharpie permanent markers, ultra-fine
