WHEREAS:

- 1. This Board intends to submit one or more propositions at a special election to be held on Tuesday, May 3, 2016.
- 2. On or before 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 9, 2016, the Board shall certify any ballot proposition to be submitted to the voters at such election to the election coordinator of coordinators designated to conduct elections within the District (the "Election Coordinator").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. A special election of the school electors of the District be called and held on Tuesday, May 3, 2016.
- 2. The propositions to be voted on at the special election shall be stated on the ballots in substantially the form as set forth in Exhibit "A".
- 3. The Election Coordinator is requested to:
- a. Utilize The Daily Telegram, a newspaper published or of general circulation with the District, for publication of notices in accordance with the election law requirements.
- b. Utilize ballot proposition summary information, as prepared by legal counsel, in the forms of the notices of last day of registration and election in the form as set forth in Exhibit "B" attached hereto.

- c. Provide a proof copy of the ballots to the District and its legal counsel in sufficient time to allow the ballots to be proofread prior to printing.
- 4. The Secretary of this Board is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this resolution with the Election Coordinator and with any Election Clerk or clerks designated to conduct elections with the District by 4:00 p.m., on Tuesday, February 9, 2016.
- 5. All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby rescinded.

EXHIBIT "A"

1. OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2016 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limit of 19 mills (\$19.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Madison School District, Lenawee County, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2017 to 2021, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2017 is approximately \$1,922,814 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2016 tax levy)?

2. MILLAGE PROPOSAL BUILDING AND SITE SINKING FUND TAX LEVY

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy and increase its building and site sinking fun millage previously approved by the electors.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Madison School District, Lenawee County, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1.5 mills (\$1.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2016 to 2020, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for, and the construction or repair of, school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2016 is approximately \$262,477 (1.25 mills of the above is a renewal of millage that expired with the 2015 tax levy and .25 mill is additional millage)?

Superintendent's Report February 15, 2016

1. FMLA/Maternity/Disability Leave Request (Action Item) - Tricia Merritt

Tricia Merritt has submitted a request for a FMLA Maternity Leave. Tricia has an expected delivery date of June 13, 2016 and, depending on her physical well-being, intends to work as close to the June 13th due date as possible.

2. MASB Board of Directors (Action Item)

I have provided information shared by MASB regarding the two candidates who wish to represent Region 7, serving on the MASB Board of Directors. Please review the information provided. The Board is asked to cast a vote for one of the two candidates.

3. Bid Award – Interior LED Lighting System Upgrade (Action Item)

The District received eight quotes from five different companies who submitted bids to supply self-replacement LED fixtures. Two of the bids met all of the specifications. GUSCO met the specifications and provided the lowest responsible bid at \$17,812. Per the bid specifications, GUSCO will submit and process all documents necessary for utility company incentives/rebates. I recommend the Board award the bid to GUSCO, the lowest responsible bidder for interior LED self-replacement fixtures.

4. Announcement from Madison Early Elementary principal Linda Kaufman (Information Item)

Linda provided the following announcement to the Madison family January 25th. Linda has, and continues to offer so much to this organization. I have included Linda's correspondence with this report for those throughout the community who may not have received her e-mail. We will continue to celebrate Linda and her contributions to the District throughout the 2015-16 school year.

After 39 years as an educator, including the last 20 years at Madison School District, I have decided that it is time for me to retire. I plan to complete the current school year before officially retiring on June 30th.

Over the last 7 years, it has been my pleasure to be the early elementary principal. During this time I have truly enjoyed working closely with all of you. We truly have a dynamic faculty and staff here at Madison. We have accomplished a great deal in these last few years!

I am truly honored to have played a role as we support our students and families. It is an honor to have the opportunity to make such a difference in the lives of our students! I offer my continued support and assistance in the transitions to come. Thank you all for the amazing journey!

5. Strategic Five-Year Facility Maintenance Plan – May Election (Information Item)

Rebecca has constructed a brochure to be shared with members of the Madison family regarding the Strategic Five-Year Facility Maintenance Plan and the May 3rd election. A copy will be e-mailed to all faculty and is currently placed on the District Website under Quick Links. It includes information regarding potential projects outlines within the Strategic Facility Maintenance Plan and illustrates information regarding the May election. Terry Etter, the new Madison Twp. Clerk and I offered for the District to host the Special School Election in May. However, the county is also putting a millage on the May Election Ballot therefore all regular precincts will be used for this election. Voters will go to their regular voting precincts where a ballot style will include the school millage proposal available for all eligible voters within the school district.

6. Enrollment (Information Item)

Count Day for school districts throughout Michigan was this past Wednesday, February 10th. The official student FTE is to be calculated, audited, and certified by the end of March, an unofficial head count indicates enrollment at approximately 1568. The head count in the fall was 1597 for a decrease of 29 students since October 7th. The following illustrates enrollment per grade level.

7. Tax Abatements (Information Item)

The total taxable value in the school district for the 2015-16 fiscal year is \$174,929,975. Six years ago the total taxable value was \$198,586,640. This loss

in taxable value has resulted in 1 mill of tax generating \$23,657.00 less revenue for our Building & Site Sinking Fund today than it did 6 years ago.

After our budget is established each year our funding is also negatively impacted by Michigan Tax Tribunal decisions that lower the value of parcels of property in the District. Often the Tax Tribunal decisions are retroactive for several years and require the District to refund thousands of dollars of tax revenue that has already been received. Below is an example of how a Michigan Tax Tribunal decision on just one parcel of commercial property in the Madison School District reduced the revenue in our Building & Site Sinking Fund by \$1,905. We typically have several decisions like this each year.

I remain hopeful that the economic climate will soon improve however, in the meantime it appears assessments will continue to show a decrease in value and we will continue to receive notice of Michigan Tax Tribunal decisions that negatively impact our funding.

Board Report Kristin Thomas, Principal Madison High School February 15, 2016

1. Parent Teacher Conferences – The winter Parent-Teacher Conferences were held on Thursday, January 21st. Historically, the winter/spring conference attendance is significantly lower than the fall conferences. In the fall, we had 55% attendance. Last month we had 43% overall attendance. The breakdown by grade level is below:

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9<sup>th</sup> Grade – 48% 10<sup>th</sup> grade – 42.5% 11<sup>th</sup> Grade – 52.6% 12<sup>th</sup> Grade – 29%
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- 2. Academic Programming for 2016-17 I am excited to share two new academic programs/offerings that will be available to students beginning in the 2016-17 school year!
 - <u>AP Language and Composition</u> This Advanced Placement course will be open to juniors. This course will replace our current Advanced English 11 course and will make the 6th Advanced Placement Course that is available to our students.
 - American Sign Language in Partnership with Lansing Community College We are currently preparing to sign an Articulation Agreement with Lansing Community College that will provide our students the opportunity to articulate 9 credit hours in American Sign Language to Lansing Community College. In addition to these 9 credits, our students will also have the opportunity to test out of an additional 3 credits potentially giving them a total of 12 credits towards a Sign Language Interpreting certificate or degree. Not only will this partnership provide all students taking ASL the opportunity to be exposed to college level coursework it will also provide students a direct pipeline to a potential high paying career that is in extremely high demand. The new courses and course sequence are as follows:

ASL1: Intro to Deaf Community (LCC SIGN 160)

ASL 1: Sign Language Part One

ASL 2A: Sign Language Part Two (LCC SIGN 161)

ASL 2B: Intermediate Sign Language Advanced Sign Language (LCC SIGN 162) Fingerspelling and Numbers (LCC SIGN 166)

3. Winter Homecoming –Congratulations to Colin Anschuetz and Kendall Hudson who were crowned Winter Homecoming king and queen. I especially want to publicly acknowledge and thank our Student Council Advisors, Jerry Pape and Marlys Ford, for their efforts in planning a fun filled homecoming week capped off by a very nice and well attended Winterfest Dance at the Lenawee Country Club!

4. National School Counseling Week – In recognition of National School Counseling Week, I would like to publicly acknowledge our HS Guidance Counselor, Mrs. Jen Stelzer. Board Report Brad Anschuetz, Principal Madison Middle School 2-15-16

- 1. Madison Middle School's musical production of Aladdin Jr. ran January 27th, 28th, and 29th. There were 658 tickets sold for the three shows. To my recollection, this was our highest count for ticket sales for the last four musicals. Congratulations to the Director, Mrs. Cyndee Risner, and the cast for a wonderful performance. There are some rising young stars our community will be able to enjoy watching over the next five to eight years.
- 2. Given the fact that the National School Counseling week is in February, I would like to take this time to publicly thank Mrs. Sylvia Sotelo for the work she does as our Middle School Counselor. She has made a significant impact with some students involved in her Student Success program. Mrs. Sotelo has been crafting lessons regarding the direct effect student choices has on achievement. These lessons touch on a different topics each time and are delivered once a month to the entire school.
- 3. Eighth grade students toured the Tech Center this past week as a prelude to long-term educational planning and the anticipated start of their high school academic coursework.
- 4. Girls on Track is seeking interested young ladies to join their program this spring. This will be the fourth year in a row that MMS has offered this opportunity. We know that girls at this age often sort through conflicting messages about their worth, their abilities and their value. - 2. Team Time: As a part of the continuous improvement process, the Team Time program was reviewed this past month. Team Time is a part of the school day when students who are identified as Title I, based on their academic needs, are provided with additional supports. It is also a time that students performing at grade level and above are provided with enrichment opportunities. As a part of the review, academic progress data was gathered and shared with the MTSS committee, the school improvement team and grade level teams. The need to implement a systemic plan (across 1st 5th grade levels) was discussed. Grade level teacher teams chose one of two variations of the plan and implementation has begun. The Early Literacy grant that Madison Elementary School received this past month will help support Team Time efforts with students who are struggling academically. An evaluation of the program will occur at the end of the school year, prior to writing the plan for 2016 17.
- 3. Embedded Ongoing Professional Development: Last month we shared the professional development plans for Martin Luther King Jr. Day. Ms. Hannah Chabazi provided a refresher focusing on integrating and infusing Evidence Based Literacy Instruction (EBLI) and infusing these skills with our Understanding by Design (UbD) Unit work. Two weeks in February, we continue the focus with embedded, on-going EBLI professional development. Hannah is back in our building, coaching teacher teams and helping us all develop a deep understanding and strong commitment to fully implement these effective strategies.
- **4. School Improvement:** The month of February is a time for the school improvement team to reflect on the progress we are making with our school improvement plan and to complete a self-assessment. This important work helps in the planning of strategies and activities that will help us meet next year's school improvement goals.

5. Counselor Week: Last week was National School Counselor Week. It is a time for us to thank our elementary counselor, Tracey Brackelman, for all the extra supports she puts in place for our students, families, and classrooms! 
