GSRP Preschool provides learning opportunities for youngest students

Madison's Great Start Readiness preschool program is now accepting new students. Children who are turning four years old, but who are less than five years old by September 1 are eligible. Children must reside in Lenawee County and meet state criteria for enrollment.

To apply: Please visit lenaweefreepreschools.org to submit the interest form. The GSRP office will then send you an application through the mail.

Complete and send the application to the GSRP at the Porter Center. (2946 Sutton Road, Adrian, MI 49221)

Someone from the GSRP office will contact you concerning your eligibility.

Please note that children are not placed into the program on a "first come first serve basis," but are prioritized by the family's income and number of other risk factors.

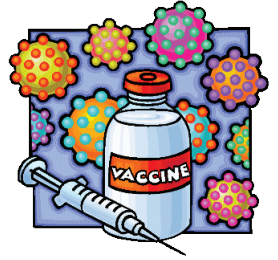


Does Your Child Need Immunizations?

Latch-Key Changes for 2017-18

If you are interested in the 2017-2018 Latch-Key before and after school care program, an application can be completed on MySchoolBucks.com. An application fee will be added to your account.

Your child's application will only be approved after all outstanding obligations are cleared from your child's *MySchoolBucks* account.

If you receive child day care assistance from the state, please notify me before the beginning of the school year as there is a form that needs to be completed and submitted for payment.

Fees and payment:

There is a non-refundable \$10.00 application fee. An application must be completed for each child.

➤ **Morning or Afternoon Session:**

\$22.50 per week for the first child and \$18.50 per week for each additional child

➤ **Morning and Afternoon Session:**

\$40.00 per week for the first child and \$33.00 for each additional child

➤ **Late Fee Charges after 5:30pm**

\$10.00 will be added to the account for every 15 minutes past close.

Flat rates will continue to be added to your account until you contact us to withdraw your child from Latch-Key. Your child may be removed from Latch-Key after two weeks of non-payment. Outstanding accounts will be turned in to the Central Office for further processing.

Payments will only be accepted on online through MySchoolBucks.com

The goal of our Latch-Key program is to provide your child with a safe and fun learning environment in which he/she will continue to grow cognitively, physically, socially, and emotionally.

Welcome Back, from the Elementary Art Room

I am looking forward to teaching your kids to enjoy, appreciate, and create art!

This year we will look and talk about major works and various styles of art in addition to using art as a means to connect students to what they are learning in the regular classroom and to reinforce what they are learning.



Every student has the right to work in a positive environment. In order to provide the best possible learning experience, we will be going over classroom expectations and guidelines in the beginning and throughout the year. I will reinforce appropriate behavior with bonus points, special activities and art projects. Inappropriate behavior will result in consequences. Student behavior will also be recorded and used as a database to keep record of and will be available to you at any time. Excessive infractions will result in a phone call home.

When viewing your child's art remember to encourage him/her to talk about it. This will help reinforce what they have learned from the experience.

In the art room we often use recycled items and use all types of materials for our art projects. To name a few: aluminum foil, plastic storage zip lock bags, paper plates, Styrofoam trays and egg cartons. With this in mind, we could use any of your egg cartons and lots of toilet paper tubes.

A donation you might want to consider is "time". If you have a special talent that you would like to share, let me know! Guest speakers are always welcome. Also if you are interested, I often have prep work for future art projects that you can work on at home and bring back when you are done.

Washington DC 2017

All current 7th grade students are invited to attend the trip as 8th graders next year. There are still available seats, but they are filling quick! Students must be in good standing in order to attend. Beginning the first day of the final trimester, March 13, 2017, students who earn 4 behavioral referrals, and/or have been suspended in or out of school are NOT considered to be in good standing. This also includes any infractions incurred during September and October of the new school year (2017-2018). If students fail 4 or more classes during the second and third trimesters of the current school year cumulatively, they will not be considered to be in good standing. There is the option of due process where the student may appeal their case to a committee panel for review. The total cost for the DC trip is \$699. 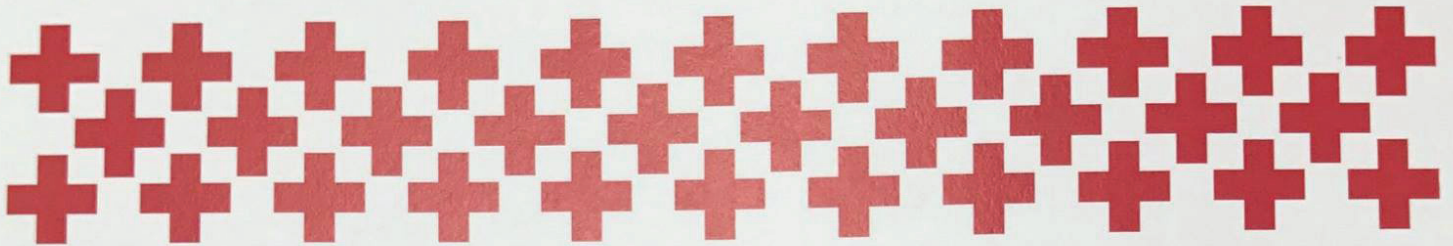

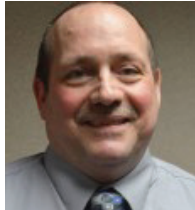
