- 4. Discussion with staff member, a phone call to parent(s), and a notice of misconduct letter sent home for parent(s) signature. A one on one visit with Administration. *30 day dismissal from the Latch-Key program.* Notice will be kept on file.
- 5. Discussion with staff member, a phone call to parent(s), and a notice of misconduct letter sent home for parent(s) signature. *Dismissed from the Latch-Key for the remainder of the year.* Notice will be kept on file.
