#### From the Superintendent's Desk:

#### **Madison Elementary School Receives Grant**

2018-19 School Improvement Goal to Focus on the "Whole Child" through strategies related to Nutrition, Physical Activity, and Social & Emotional Health

This spring, Madison Elementary School was awarded the Incorporating Health and Wellness Into School Improvement Plans Statewide Pilot (IHSIP) grant. This grant is funded by the Michigan Health Endowment Fund to begin the work of incorporating a health related goal into the School Improvement Plan.

Michigan Elementary & Middle School Principals Association (MEMSPA) is collaborating with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS), Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and the Michigan School Health Coordinators Association (MiSHCA) to Integrate Health Into School Improvement Planning. Madison Elementary School is one of 12 schools in Michigan chosen to focus on Student Health and Academic Achievement. This is a process grant that invites schools to attend to the needs of the whole child. We recognize that, "Together, we can make a difference".

Our 2018-19 School Improvement plan will include a health related goal with three measurable objectives. By implementing strategies related to nutrition, physical activity, and social & emotional health, we will improve our school health and, as a result, we expect to see improved academic performance and fewer behavior incidents.

One difference you'll notice this year is the way we celebrate birthdays. In lieu of birthday treats, we will celebrate your child's birthday with a special activity. At the June Board of Education meeting, the Madison Board of Education approved the following update to the Madison Elementary Handbook:

At Madison Elementary School, we believe keeping children healthy and safe. The rate of childhood obesity, food allergies, food sensitivities, and foodborne illness is increasing at an alarming rate. To that end, we will partner with you to promote our nutritional goals.

#### **Birthday Celebrations**

We ask for your support for food-free birthday celebrations. We realize that children want to feel special on their birthday, but we ask that we do not use food in the classroom to celebrate. Instead, we will ask your child to choose a special activity from the birthday celebration menu, empowering your child to choose an activity to make his or her special day a memorable one. If there is something that your child would rather do, please contact the teacher. Activities should be able to be completed/shared in 15 minutes. Your child's teacher will communicate with you near the time of his or her birthday. The Madison birthday celebration menu includes:

- Choice Time

- Classroom Games
- Guided Drawing/Art Project
- Favorite Book/Guest Read Aloud





#### **Latch-Key Registrations for 2018-19 School Year**

Open registration will begin on May 4, 2018. There are 96 online applications that will be available for the year.

If you are interested in the 2018-2019 Latch-Key before and after school care program, an application can be completed on My School Bucks. A non-refundable \$10.00 application fee will be added to your account. An application must be completed for each child.

Your child's application will only be approved after all outstanding obligations are cleared from your child's My School Bucks account.

If you receive child day care assistance from the state, please notify me before the beginning of the school year as there is a form that needs to be completed and submitted to the State.

#### Fees and payment:

#### **Morning OR Afternoon Session:**

- \$22.50 per week for the first child and \$18.50 per week for each additional child

#### Morning AND Afternoon Session:

- \$40.00 per week for the first child and \$33.00 for each additional child

#### Late Fee Charges after 5:30pm\*

- \$10.00 will be added to the account for 1-15 minutes past the end of the program
- \$20.00 will be added to the account for 15-30 minutes past the end of the program
- \*State paid childcare will not cover late fees.

Flat rates will continue to be added to your account until you contact us to withdraw your child from Latch-Key. Your child may be removed from Latch-Key after two weeks of non-payment. Outstanding accounts will be turned in to the Central Office for further processing.

#### Payments will only be accepted on online on My School Bucks.

The goal of our Latch-Key program is to provide your child with a safe and fun learning environment in which s/he will continue to grow cognitively, physically, socially and emotionally.



#### Middle School Quiz Bowl to Compete at Lenawee County Fair

The Madison Middle School Quiz Bowl teams will be showing off their academic wits at the final Quiz Bowl Competition hosted by the Lenawee County Fair this summer. This event will take place at the Band Shell in the fair grounds on Monday, July 23rd at 4:00pm. The teams previously competed in a qualifying tournament for this event back in April.

#### Middle School Summer School Classes Being Offered

If a middle school student did not earn credit in one or more required classes this school year, he/she needs to enroll in summer school to stay on track with their current graduation class.

Credit recovery courses will be completed on the computer utilizing a web-based program, Edgenuity (formally known as E2020). Classes will begin on Monday, July 9th and end on Friday, August 17th. Students may complete as many courses as they wish during this period for a one-time, flat fee of \$70.

The summer school daily schedule will be 8:30am – 11:30am (Monday- Friday). Students will be provided transportation, however, space is limited to the first 50 students that sign up on a first come, first serve basis.

Please see the Middle School office for a registration form. In order to reserve a bus seat, the \$70 payment must be received in full.

#### 8th Grade Northern Michigan Trip - Fall 2018

Current 7th grade students (next year's 8th graders) will be taking a trip to Northern Michigan in the Fall of 2018! The trip includes stops at Mackinaw City, Castle Rock, Sault Ste. Marie, Tahquamenon Falls, and more!


