From the Superintendent's Desk:

Madison Elementary School Receives Grant

2018-19 School Improvement Goal to Focus on the "Whole Child" through strategies related to Nutrition, Physical Activity, and Social & Emotional Health

This spring, Madison Elementary School was awarded the Incorporating Health and Wellness Into School Improvement Plans Statewide Pilot (IHSIP) grant. This grant is funded by the Michigan Health Endowment Fund to begin the work of incorporating a health related goal into the School Improvement Plan.

Michigan Elementary & Middle School Principals Association (MEMSPA) is collaborating with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS), Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and the Michigan School Health Coordinators Association (MiSHCA) to Integrate Health Into School Improvement Planning. Madison Elementary School is one of 12 schools in Michigan chosen to focus on Student Health and Academic Achievement. This is a process grant that invites schools to attend to the needs of the whole child. We recognize that, "Together, we can make a difference".

Our 2018-19 School Improvement plan will include a health related goal with three measurable objectives. By implementing strategies related to nutrition, physical activity, and social & emotional health, we will improve our school health and, as a result, we expect to see improved academic performance and fewer behavior incidents.

One difference you'll notice this year is the way we celebrate birthdays. In lieu of birthday treats, we will celebrate your child's birthday with a special activity. At the June Board of Education meeting, the Madison Board of Education approved the following update to the Madison Elementary Handbook:

At Madison Elementary School, we believe keeping children healthy and safe. The rate of childhood obesity, food allergies, food sensitivities, and foodborne illness is increasing at an alarming rate. To that end, we will partner with you to promote our nutritional goals.

Why: An effort by the District to reduce traffic flow at Madison Elementary School before and after school, and as a service to parents/guardians

- Less congested traffic flow and parking lot with a more efficient drop off and pick up process

Benefits to parents/guardians are:

- Opportunity to meet the bus between 7:50 and 7:55 a.m. and depart to work or home with no delay
- Eliminate the need to rush to school between 3:00-3:30 to park and pick up your child. Simply meet the bus at 3:45 p.m. avoiding inclement weather, with plenty of room to park

Where: Corner of 223 and Treat (very north end of the Family Restaurant parking lot)

Parking and Drop Off Guidelines

Attention Elementary Parents: during drop off please avoid using the reserve parking for our Foster Grandparents. Our volunteers give over 20 volunteer hours a week and need to be in their classroom early. Thank you for your consideration in this matter.



Please do not bring pets on school district property. Per Board Policy 8390, animals are not permitted on campus.

Animals permitted in schools and elsewhere on District property shall be limited to those necessary to support specific curriculum-related projects and activities, those that provide assistance to a student or staff member due to a disability (e.g., seizure disorder), those that provide a reasonable accommodation to a student in accordance with a Section 504 Plan, or those that serve as service animals as required by Federal and State law.

Taking into consideration that some animals can cause or exacerbate allergic reactions, spread bacterial infections, or cause damage and create a hazard if they escape from confinement, the Principal may permit non-service animals to be present in classrooms to support curriculum-related projects and activities only under the following conditions:

- A. the staff member seeking approval to have a non-service animal in his/her classroom shall:
 - 1. provide a current satisfactory health certificate or report of examination from a veterinarian for the animal;
 - 2. take precautions deemed necessary to protect the health and safety of students and other staff;
 - 3. ensure that the animal is treated humanely, keeping it in a healthy condition and in appropriate housing (e.g., a cage or tank) that is properly cleaned and maintained; and,
 - 4. keep the surrounding areas in a clean and sanitary condition at all times;
- B. other staff members and parents of students in areas potentially affected by animals have been notified in writing and adjustments have been made to accommodate verified health-related or other concerns.






High School Musical Auditions - "The Addams Family: School Edition"

Middle School Volleyball Info


