## What is Move this World?

Madison Elementary School has adopted a social emotional learning program called Move this World. Move this World provides multimedia content for our school and teachers to develop social skills and strengthen emotional intelligence within students. The curriculum aligns with the five social emotional learning core competencies (self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and decision making) as defined by the Collaborative for Academic, Social and Emotional Learning (CASEL) and is reviewed annually by the American Institute of Research. The curriculum is scaffold so that skills build upon one another throughout the school year.

To help support learning at home, please refer to the following resources from Move this World. The “Emotional ABCs” poster helps students identify emotions. The “Emoger” poster provides skills to help students manage his or her emotions. Hearing this language at home and school, will strengthen students’ social emotional strategies. Ask your child to tell you about it. If you have questions about Move this World, please feel free to contact your child’s teacher or building principal.
