## About Title I

**Title I is a federally-funded program under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965.**

**Purpose:** To help low-achieving students meet the state's challenging academic content and performance standards. The Title I program offers a variety of services which may include: additional teachers and support staff, extra time for instruction, a variety of teaching methods and materials, smaller class sizes, and additional training for staff.

**Qualifications:** Schools qualify for funds based on economic need. Madison Elementary School follows the School-Wide Title I program design.
