# BOARD RESOLUTION FOR STUDENT DISCIPLINE

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member Greg Choinski and supported by Member Eric McDonald:

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The administration has recommended that a student whose identity is known to the Board (the "Student") be expelled for possessing a vaporizer while at school, conduct which is in violation of a behavioral contract agreed upon by the Student and the District on November 14, 2018 (the "Contract").
- 2. Additionally, the Student on December 13, 2018, the Student engaged in behavior which was insubordinate and later failed on two separate occasions to serve a scheduled detention resulting from the Student's behavior. Furthermore, the Student is currently failing two courses. This conduct is also in violation of the Contract.
- 3. The Contract between the Student and the District clearly stated that any further violation of the Contract by the Student would result in the immediate suspension of the Student from school and a recommendation by the District administration that the Student be expelled from the Madison School District.
- 4. School administrators notified the Student's parents/guardians of the specific charge underlying the discipline recommendation, as well as the date, time, and place of the disciplinary hearing.
- 5. The hearing afforded the Student and the Student's representatives an opportunity to respond to the charge and to present pertinent evidence for the Board's consideration.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. A preponderance of the evidence establishes that on December 19, 2018, the Student, possessed a vaporizer at school in violation of the following Madison School District policies: Tobacco Use, page 22 of the Madison High School Handbook.
- 2. The Student's possession of the vaporizer at school, insubordinate conduct, and failing grades are a clear violation of the Contract established between the Student and the District, which placed the Student on notice that further behavior in violation of the District's policies may result in expulsion from school.
- 3. Based on careful consideration of all of the following factors, the Board determines that expulsion is warranted:
  - The student's age;
  - The student's disciplinary history;
  - Whether the student has a disability;
  - The seriousness of the behavior;
  - Whether the behavior posed a safety risk;
  - Whether restorative practices are a better option; and
  - Whether lesser interventions would address the behavior.
  - 4. The Student is permanently expelled from the District.
- 5. During the time of the expulsion, the Student may not be on school grounds or attend any functions at the District without prior written approval from the Superintendent.
- 6. Consistent with Sections 11a and 1311(1) of the Revised School Code, the Board finds that the interests of the District are served by this resolution.
- 7. Administrators are directed and authorized to implement all terms of this resolution and are delegated all necessary authority to do so.
- 8. All resolutions and parts of resolutions that conflict with the provisions of this resolution are rescinded.

# 1) Election - MASB Board of Directors (Action Item)

The District received the official 2019 ballot to elect members to the MASB Board of Directors. You and other school board members throughout the state of Michigan will vote to decide who governs their Association. You may have received information from MASB regarding the candidates. If not, candidate information is placed within your board packet. There are two (2) candidates from Region 7 from which you can choose. The candidate elected will serve a three-year term. Board Report Kristin Thomas, Principal Madison High School February 25, 2019

- I. Winter Homecoming –Congratulations to Anthony Contreras and Kaiya Wall who were crowned Winter Homecoming king and queen! I also want to publically acknowledge the work of Angela Tedora in organizing all the activities that go into Homecoming Week. Angela does a great job and provided a fun filled homecoming week for our student body capped off by a fun and well attended Winterfest Dance at Siena Heights University!
- II. Costa Rica Trip Last year you recall that Rachel Wallace came to the board requesting to pursue an opportunity to take students on an international trip over Spring Break. I am attaching the itinerary and travel details for the trip. We have 15 people traveling in total.
- III. HOSA Our HOSA chapter, under the direction of Mrs. McGormley, competed in January at the Regional HOSA competition. We had 22 students compete and 21 of those students finished in top ten! This is only the 2<sup>nd</sup> year for our HOSA Chapter, so this is definitely an accomplishment! Of the 21 students who finished in the top ten, 11 students came home with medals and will be moving on to the State Competition in March. Many of these students, along with Mrs. McGormley, put in significant time practicing and studying over the Christmas Break to prepare for the competition and I am proud of their efforts and the manner in which they represented Madison.
- IV. Science Olympiad On Saturday, Dr. Cichy took 13 students to Hillsdale College to participate in a regional Science Olympiad Competition. Board Report Brad Anschuetz, Principal Madison Middle School February 25, 2019

I. Fine Arts Program: When you consider the talent that was performing on stage, I sat in awe on Sunday, 10 February, watching the musical *Once Upon an Island*. One student after another, when it was their chance to shine, performed at such a high level. Congratulations to Mrs. Erin Pifer, Director, Mrs. Cyndee Risner, Chorographer, Mrs. Mandy Kruse, Musical Director, and Mrs. Jen Baur, Producer, for putting on a first class production. Fifty-two (52) middle level students were involved with the musical. Approximately 770 attendees took in the three shows from February 8<sup>th</sup> through February 10<sup>th</sup>.

Mrs. Heather Yeager shared with the faculty the five pieces of art that are moving on to the State Art Showcase. Madison Middle School Art program went five-for-five with all entries taking recognition at the Regional Art Exhibit. The students being honored were Annie McDade (8<sup>th</sup>), Michael Fox (8<sup>th</sup>), Justin Fox (8<sup>th</sup>), Rowen Yeager (6<sup>th</sup>), and Teagan Sullivan (6<sup>th</sup>). It wouldn't surprise me if a few of these pieces are recognized in the "Top 100" or even the "Top 15" in the state for middle level students. Madison Middle School Art program has placed a student in either the "Top 100" or "Top 15" for the past four years in a row.

The Orchestra, Choir, and Band programs are gearing up for their pre-festival concert. Every time I hear them perform they just get better and better. Mrs. Marcie Zeckner and Mr. Eric Strasshofer have certainly taken our music programs to another level. The amount of fun and excitement they both exude when their groups are performing is inspirational.

There are a lot of talented young men and women walking these hallways. I am very thankful to everyone for helping all of our students reach their full potential in this ever changing world.

- II. Professional Development: Middle school teachers participated in a half day of professional development on 15 February 2019. Teachers involved in the College, Career, and Community Readiness Program worked on the National Writing Project standards. Sixth-grade ELA and Math teachers worked with fifth-grade teachers regarding first trimester standards for sixth-grade and expectations; special attention was given to writing standards. Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies teachers reviewed PSAT data and developed action plans to address deficiencies. Social Studies teachers also worked with the high school Economics Department to develop middle level economic standards. Special needs teachers worked with Mrs. Chris Lobkovich, Coordinator of Special Education, to expound on differentiation strategies. Finally, the Physical Education Department analyzed the Michigan Physical Education and Health standards to address alignment with curriculum.
- III. **Reproductive Health Educational Program:** Our eighth-grade students participated in the Reproductive Health Educational Program on February 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, and 19<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Jill Hogle, Mr. Josh Powers, and Mrs. Mindy Jordan coordinate this program for the middle school. Madison Middle School students

receive educational programming on reproductive health during their sixth-grade and eighth-grade academic years.

IV. National School Counseling Week: Given the fact that the National School Counseling week was celebrated February  $4^{th} - 8^{th}$ , I would like to take this time to publicly thank Mrs. Sylvia Sotelo for the work she does as our Middle School Counselor. She has made a significant impact with students involved in her Student Success program. Furthermore, there have been several students working through personal trauma in their lives. Mrs. Sotelo has been a great resource for these students and their families.

**V. Parent Teacher Conferences:** Parent Teacher Conferences were held on 24 January 2019. Attendance was steady, but relatively low compared to past years. The conferences were attended by 51% of the parents. The attendance rate for this conference usually falls between 62% and 65%. Weather was a contributing factor to this attendance rate.

### Nate Pechaitis & Abby Miller

1. Professional Development: On MLK Day, our teachers participated in two sessions. One session was used to learn about Illuminate DNA, a data warehousing system that was purchased by the LISD. They learned how to create assessments and run reports. This was the platform used to generate our Individual Reading Improvement Plans (IRIPs).

The second part of the day was spent learning strategies for differentiated and small group math instruction. We were presented with several strategies, and encouraged to try one or two to take back to the classroom right away. We also learned about Math Progressions work. Every elementary math concept can be traced back to when it was introduced, and then how it develops. You can see these progressions here: <a href="https://gfletchy.com/progression-videos/">https://gfletchy.com/progression-videos/</a>. Using these videos, we can break down concepts and identify where students' understanding of a concept begins or ends. We can then be responsive to student deficiencies by using one of the strategies we learned.

**2. February 15**<sup>th</sup> **Professional Learning:** Early elementary spent the afternoon analyzing the results of our Middle of the Year Math Assessment. Collectively, they were able to determine areas of strengths and challenges. They have developed a plan to address challenges.

Third grade teachers worked with Heidi Miller to align Phonics Dance with EBLI as part a yearlong scope and sequence. They have been working closely with Heidi all year. She has been coaching them to develop continuity between the classrooms. This was an opportunity to solidify a cohesive alignment among the third grade classrooms, as well as part of the continuum starting in previous grade levels.

The fourth grade team worked with Nate to learn about Secondary Traumatic Stress. When teachers/caregivers spend a large amount of time with students who have traumatic experiences, can experience stress, fatigue, and despair. The team learned about strategies to be proactive and preventative to limit the negative impact of the impact. In addition, they discussed next steps for the children in 4<sup>th</sup> grade who have traumatic experiences. Nate, Eric, and Tracey are developing a plan for additional social-emotional learning and mentorship for these children.

Fifth grade teachers worked with 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers, Jackie Cebulski and Renee Forche. Again, the focus was to both vertically and horizontally align English and Math Curriculum. There was an emphasis on writing in English. 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers learned about 6<sup>th</sup> grade academic expectations and developed a plan for the transition from grade 5 to 6. Sixth and fifth graders will begin Buddy Journals to correspond with each other resulting in an informational "survival guide" for sixth grade. In addition, they will be working together to develop a Rates/Ratio Unit since it is no longer part of the 5<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum.



Isom also has served as part of the MHSAA Representative Council since 2008, representing Class C and D schools from the state's southeastern section.

"I'm very honored by this award, not only because it's for women in leadership. I've been doing this 33 years and I've seen more and more women in this profession ... that for all things considered is a man's profession," Isom said. "Having a daughter, who while she's not following my footsteps, but getting her in the business world eventually, it's a good feeling."

Isom's contributions to high school sports and its participants are many and at all levels. Within her district, she has coached various levels of basketball, volleyball, sideline cheer, track & field and softball – at least one sport every year, including as the eighth grade girls basketball coach this season.

At the league level, Isom has served as president of the Tri-County Conference since 2002 after previously serving as vice president and secretary/treasurer. Serving more of her neighboring districts, Isom has hosted numerous District, Regional and Quarterfinal competitions and MHSAA Coaches Advancement Program (CAP) sessions.

All the while, she continued to serve as a class advisor to Madison students through last year, when her daughter Rachel graduated, and continues to teach health and physical education at the high school.

"I like being in the classroom and coaching because I still have a connection with kids, know who they are," Isom said. "Being at a smaller school, you're able to know who kids are, but at the middle school especially I don't know a lot. Getting involved in coaching has helped me put a name with a face so I will know them coming up."

At the statewide level, Isom has provided her expertise as a member of the Representative Council and 33-year member of the Michigan Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association and National Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association. She also assists MHSAA staff annually in selecting members of the 16-student Student Advisory Council.

She was named the MIAAA's Region 6 "Athletic Director of the Year" in 2000 and received the MHSAA's Allen W. Bush Award in 2016 to recognize her many behind-the-scenes contributions.

"Kris Isom continues to provide a steadying presence on our Representative Council. She researches issues and really brings a voice of reason to the discussion – not only to the full Council, but to the Executive Committee as well," MHSAA Executive Director Mark Uyl said. "She does a great job representing the southeastern corner of the state, bringing a small-school perspective to the table time after time. We're thankful for her leadership and glad to present her with the Women In Sports Leadership Award."

A graduate of Clinton High School, Isom received her bachelor's degree in science and teaching certification in physical education and health in 1984 from Michigan State University. She earned her master's in elementary education in 1986 from Eastern Michigan University and also has completed graduate courses from Fresno Pacific University.

In addition to the MIAAA and NIAAA, Isom is a member of the Michigan Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance (MAHPERD) and the Michigan State University Alumni Association. She's active with The Clinton United Church of Christ in various service projects, including an annual fundraiser for cancer research, and also participates in local Meals on Wheels, American Red Cross and Habitat for Humanity projects.
