BOARD RESOLUTION FOR STUDENT DISCIPLINE

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member Julie Ramos and supported by Member Natasha Manchester.

WHEREAS:

- 1. The administration has recommended that a student whose identity is known to the Board (the "Student") be suspended for possessing prescription medication while at school which did not belong to the Student and providing the prescription medication to another student.
- 2. School administrators notified the Student's parents of the specific charge underlying the discipline recommendation, as well as the date, time, and place of the disciplinary hearing.
- 3. Pursuant to the request of the Student's parents, and as authorized by Section 8(b) of the Michigan Open Meetings Act, MCL 15.268(b), the disciplinary hearing was conducted in a closed session meeting of the Board.
- 4. The hearing afforded the Student and the Student's representatives an opportunity to respond to the charge and to present pertinent evidence for the Board's consideration.
- 5. The Board has carefully considered all of the evidence produced in this student discipline hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. A preponderance of the evidence establishes that on January 18, 2019, the Student possessed prescription medication while at school which did not belong to the Student and provided the prescription medication to another student in violation of the following sections of the Madison Middle School Student and Parent Handbook: Drugs & Alcohol, page 19, and Madison School District Board Policy: Drug Prevention, Board Policy 5530.
- 2. Based on careful consideration of all of the following factors, the Board determines that expulsion is not warranted, but that suspension is:
 - The student's age;
 - The student's disciplinary history;
 - Whether the student has a disability;
 - The seriousness of the behavior;

- Whether the behavior posed a safety risk;
- Whether restorative practices are a better option; and
- Whether lesser interventions would address the behavior.
- 3. The Student is suspended for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year and is eligible to return to school at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year.
- 4. During the time of the suspension, the Student may not be on school grounds or attend any functions at the District without prior written approval from the Superintendent.
- 5. Consistent with Sections 11a and 1311(1) of the Revised School Code, the Board finds that the interests of the District are served by this resolution.
- 6. Administrators are directed and authorized to implement all terms of this resolution and are delegated all necessary authority to do so.
- 7. All resolutions and parts of resolutions that conflict with the provisions of this resolution are rescinded.

If approved each Madison graduate planning to enter the military will receive a cord along with a hand written note recognizing the individual's selfless sacrifice for our country. School districts including Adrian, Sand Creek, Blissfield, Tecumseh, Whiteford, Summerfield, Britton-Deerfield, and Adrian College currently participate with Cords Across America to recognize graduates entering any military branch, National Guard, ROTC, or a military academy. Kristin and I recommend the board approve participation with Cords Across America, recognizing Madison High School graduates who willingly volunteer to serve our country.

5. Amendment – Health Plan A and Health Plan B Purchasing Consortium Agreements (Action Item)

The Consortium Governing Board held a meeting December 13, 2018 at which the Board unanimously voted to amend four sections within the agreements. The sections include 5.3, 6.8, 7.4, and 9.1. I have placed copies of the Amendment to the Health Plan A Purchasing Consortium Agreement and Amendment to the Health Plan B Purchasing Consortium Agreement in your board packet.

Jennifer was present at the Consortium Governing Board meeting as members recently met to discuss the amendments and aspects of the Hillsdale ISD and its constituent districts joining the Health Care Consortium.

Jennifer and I recommend the board approve the Amendment to the Health Plan A Purchasing Consortium Agreement and Amendment to the Health Plan B Purchasing Consortium Agreement as presented.

AMENDMENT TO THE HEALTH PLAN A PURCHASING CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT

This Amendment to the Health Plan A Purchasing Consortium Agreement (hereinafter, the "Amendment") made this 13th day of March, 2019, by and between the **Lenawee Intermediate School District** (hereinafter, "LISD") and **Madison School District**, (each individually a "member" and collectively the "Consortium").

WHEREAS, on or about the 17 day of September, 2012, the Consortium was established by the LISD and its constituent districts to create a mechanism for collectively purchasing insured medical benefits and coverage as well as health care plan services and related administrative services in order to achieve efficiencies and cost reductions in health care expenditures; and

WHEREAS, Section six of the Health Plan A Purchasing Consortium Agreement (hereinafter, the "Agreement") set forth the responsibilities of the fiscal agent and identified the ISD as the fiscal agent (Section 6.8 of the Agreement); and

WHEREAS, Section 9.1 of the Agreement stipulates that in order to become a member of the Consortium, the entity must be a general powers school district, intermediate school district, or public school academy located with the geographical boundaries of ISD; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Consortium Governing Board held on September 21, 2018, at which 11 of the 12 members of the Consortium were present and represented, the Consortium Governing Board unanimously voted to allow the Hillsdale County Intermediate School District and its constituent school districts to join the Consortium effective January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Section 12 of the Agreement stipulates that an amendment to the Agreement is only effective upon the execution of the amendment approved by at least 2/3rd of the Consortium Governing Board; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Consortium Governing Board held on December 13, 2018, at which 8 of the 12 members of the Consortium (2/3rd of the membership) were present and represented, the Consortium Governing Board unanimously voted to amend the Agreement as is set forth in this Amendment; and

WHEREAS, the consideration contained in the Agreement forms the basis for this Amendment; and

WHEREAS, except as amended by this Amendment, the remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement and any earlier amendments will remain in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and benefits contained in the Agreement, the members of the Consortium agree as follows:

1. Section 5.3 of the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

- 5.3 The Governing Board shall be responsible for selected a Steering Committee consisting of five (5) members of the Governing Board that represent the LISD or a constituent district of the LISD and two (2) members of the Governing Board that represent the Hillsdale County Intermediate School District or a constituent district of the Hillsdale County Intermediate School District. In addition, the Superintendent (or designee) of the Fiscal Agent district shall serve as a member of the Steering Committee. The Steering Committee shall be responsible for carrying out the operational aspects of the Consortium, to the extent that such matters have been delegated to the Steering Committee by the Governing Board.
- 2. Section 6.8 of the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:
 - 6.8 The LISD shall serve as the Fiscal Agent to the Consortium until such time as it voluntarily relinquishes that position in writing or at such time that the Governing Board votes by 2/3 majority to replace the LISD as Fiscal Agent.
- 3. Section 7.4 of the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:
 - 7.4 The Fiscal Agent shall receive administrative fees for its services. The amount of administrative fees payable by each member of the Consortium shall be determined by a formula to be determined by the Consortium Governing Board that is acceptable to the Fiscal Agent attributable to the Service(s) in which the member participates. The administrative fees shall be assessed and paid monthly to the Fiscal Agent by each member of the Consortium. The Governing Board shall annually (by June 30) review the administrative fee and may modify that fee by two-thirds (2/3) majority vote.
- 4. Section 9.1 of the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:
 - 9.1 In order to be eligible to become a member of the Consortium, the entity must be a general powers school district, intermediate school district, or public school academy located within the geographical boundaries of the state of Michigan.

New members may join the Consortium upon a 2/3 majority vote of the Governing Board and the express obligation to be bound by the terms of this Agreement, as may be modified from time to time. Existing members may withdraw from the Consortium in accordance with Section 9.2 below. A withdrawing member forfeits any right to a distribution of Consortium assets or funds upon termination and dissolution, which right shall revert to the remaining and non-withdrawing members.

If a new member is admitted to the Consortium, under the procedures specified above, the expiration of its initial commitment to membership

shall coincide with the expiration of the membership interval for other members of the Consortium as is specified in Section 9.2.

5. Miscellaneous.

- (a) Except as specifically modified by this Amendment, the Agreement and all earlier amendments will continue in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and confirmed by this Amendment.
- (b) This Amendment shall be construed, interpreted and enforced under the laws of the State of Michigan.
- (c) This Amendment is binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the Parties and their respective permitted successors and assigns.
- (d) In the event of any conflict between the terms of this Amendment and the terms of the Agreement, the terms of this Amendment shall govern and control.
- (e) This Amendment may be executed in separate counterparts, including facsimile copies, each of which shall be deemed an original, all of which counterparts shall constitute one in the same Amendment.

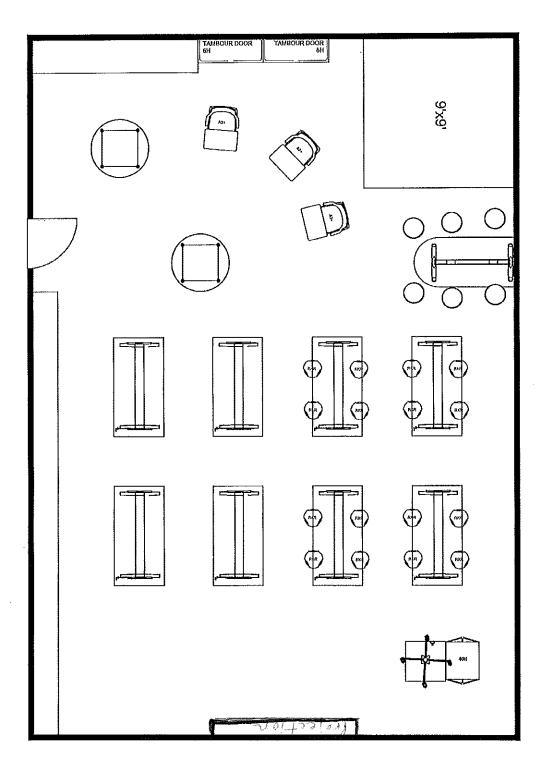
- I. Testing The Assessment Season is upon us! Our 11th grade students will take the SAT on Tuesday, April 9th, the ACT WorkKeys on Wednesday, April 10th, and the M-Step for Science and Social Studies the following week. Our sophomores will take the PSAT 10 on Thursday, April 11th and our freshmen will take the PSAT 8/9 on Wednesday, April 10th. In addition to these assessments, we will also be NWEA testing in later April/Early May. Our seniors will also retake the COMPASS college placement test in May. AP Exams will be administered during the 2nd & 3rd weeks of May.
- II. Hudson Tech Alternative Program Throughout the course of this school year we have had a group of students who have struggled to achieve academic success. We provided these students with every resource we had available, but for a variety of reasons, we were not able to move the dial with these students. - **I. Madison Middle School Art program** has placed a student in either the "Top 100" or "Top 15" for the past four years in a row. I am proud to announce that Teagan Sullivan, 6th grade, (Cat, Mixed Media piece 18"x24"), Michael Fox, 8th grade, (Brick-wall & Space piece, Charcoal, Pencil & Acrylic Paint), and Rowen Yeager, 6th grade, (Light-bulbs, Watercolor painting) won Top 100 at the state level competition for their art pieces while Annie McDade, 8th grade, (Calum Hood, Pencil Drawing) won Top 15! Top 15 is the highest honor at the middle school level.
- **Michigan Tour** from October 3rd, 2019 through October 5th, 2019. The cost of the trip is \$590 and includes all meals, accommodations, and admittance tickets. Among other opportunities, students will tour the Historic Mill Creek Discovery Park, visit Colonial Michilimackinac, watch a Jack Pine Lumberjack Show, visit Castle Rock, take a Pictured Rocks boat cruise, admire the Tahquamenon Falls, ride a ferry over to Mackinac Island, and visit Fort Makinac.
