Certified Birth Certificate (present original, not a copy)
Proof of Residency (utility bill, rental or purchase agreement)
Immunization Records

Copies will be made of the birth certificate, proof of residency, and immunization records, with the originals returned to the parent/guardian.

Third Grade "How Does Your Garden Grow?" Program

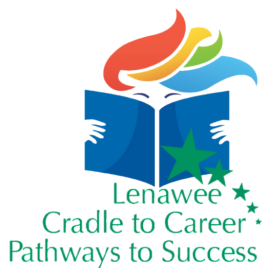
