



From the Superintendent's Desk

Monday, November 30th

I hope that everyone had a restful Thanksgiving holiday! I know that this year the holiday season has looked different for all of our families including my own. Monday, November 30, we embark on the start of the second trimester. We will have both face-to-face and virtual instruction for our PK-8th grade students, and high school students will begin as remote learners per the guidance of the State.

As we begin the second trimester offering face-to-face instruction for our PK-8th grade families. I urge you to be extremely diligent in monitoring your student(s) for potential COVID-19 symptoms. Our instructional delivery model was created in a way that students can stay up-to-date with their instruction from home or in the district building. Most colleges and universities ended their face-to-face instruction at the Thanksgiving break to reduce any potential exposure from students returning from traveling home for the holidays. PK-12 education did not take that approach. So, we are relying on the partnerships with our families to reduce the risk of positive cases in our buildings. If your students were around someone that may be COVID-19 positive please keep your student home. Below, you will find the COVID-19 symptom checklist. Madison High Schoolers Excel at VFW Voice of Democracy Competition

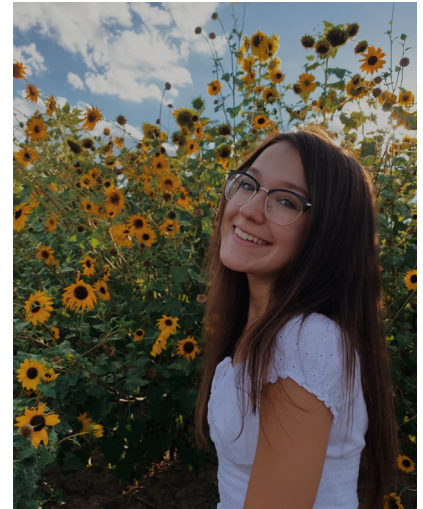

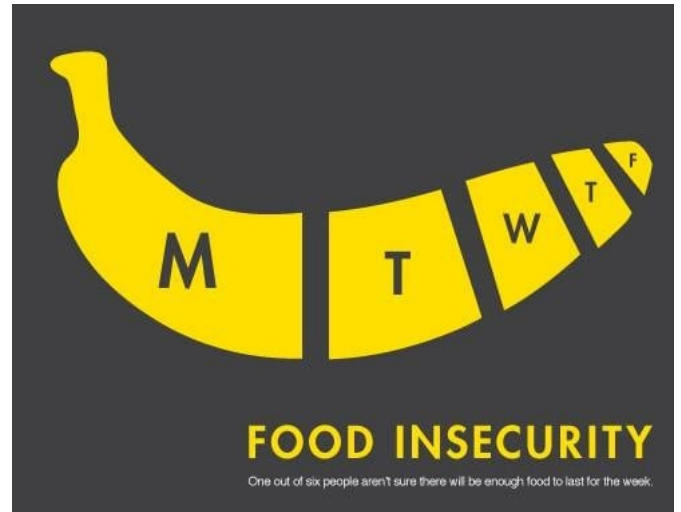
