Good Afternoon, Madison Families!

I hope that everyone has had a restful holiday break! Today (Monday, January 4, 2021), we are excited to be able return to Face-to-Face instruction for PK-12th grade students. Due to executive orders from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, our high school hallways have been quiet for quite some time. Today that all changes and our high school students are able to return! While we are looking forward to having students back in the building, we know that we all need to remain vigilant in an effort to minimize the spread of COVID-19 as much as possible. As a district, we will continue to implement numerous safety measures. These safety measures have allowed us to contain positive cases to smaller groups of individuals being identified as close contacts. Some of these measures include:

- Cohorting groups of students
- Masks worn by ALL PK-12 students and staff in the building
- Hand washing and use of hand sanitizer
- Temperature checks of all PK-12 students and staff

Madison Debate Team Ends the Season on a Winning Note


This year's Lenawee County debate competitions moved to a virtual platform hosted by the National Debate Coaches Association (NDCA). Four high schools competed this year: Blissfield, Hudson, Lenawee Christian, and Madison. A special thank you is given to the LCS coach who took the lead in coordinating the competitions through her membership in the NDCA. Students and judges logged into their match "room" for each debate (see the screenshot picture of a sample "room"). Despite audio, video, and firewall challenges, the season was quite a success. Students advanced their debating skills and some of the best matches ever occurred. No trophies were awarded this year. Nonetheless, Madison debaters excelled in their competitions and ended the season on a winning note in the novice and varsity rounds.

Novice debaters were Paulina Graham and Nolan Matthews who competed twice; Tavia Kingsley competed once solo as Nevaeh Gates had firewall issues and was unable to join their match. Varsity debaters who competed in all three competitions were Alayna Wagner and Matson Garza.
