Safe Routes to School Poster Contest

This spring, Madison Elementary School is coordinating an incentive program to encourage students to stay healthy and active by using the sidewalks to get to school. Mrs. McNeil, our world renowned art teacher, kicked off our Safe Routes to School Club by teaching a traffic safety unit and hosting a poster making contest for grades 1-5. Safety tips were incorporated into the artwork. The top five posters from each grade level were posted in the hallway. The winning artists received a small prize were recognized on the morning announcements.

The rules for the incentive program are as follows:

- 1. Students interested in the Safe Routes to School Club can get a punch card from their teacher.
- 2. Each time a student walks, runs or bikes to or from school, they will pass a crossing guard, who will punch a hole in the student's card. Students can get a maximum of 2 punches per day.
- 3. After a child receives 10 punches, they will visit Mrs. Graham or Ms. Sevilla in the Media center to receive a small prize. Students will get a new punch card at this time.
- 4. Their card will be collected and entered in the grand prize drawing at the end of the year. There is no limit to the number of cards a child can enter into the grand prize drawing.

It was great to see many similarities from his real-life experiences to what was learned throughout the trimester. When reflecting on the visit, students responded that they thought it was interesting that planes can fly with a busted engine and still land safely. We learned that every system has a backup and there is a backup to that backup system! Additionally, Captains have four stripes on their jacket sleeves and First Officers only have three. We learned that American Airlines send their pilots to training every 9 months and they must pass tests with a 100%.



Complete and send the application in the self-addressed envelope provided by GSRP, or deliver it to the GSRP at the Porter Center. (2946 Sutton Road, Adrian, MI 49221)

Someone from the GSRP office will contact you concerning your eligibility.

Please note that children are not placed into the program on a "first come first serve basis," but are prioritized by the family's income and number of other risk factors.
