HS Spanish Students Partnering with Pulsera Project

Next week (May 3-7), Madison High School Spanish 3B students will be partnering with The Pulsera Project, a fair trade nonprofit organization that seeks to empower, inspire, and educate people in Central America and the U.S.

The Pulsera Project provides sustainable, well-paying work opportunities for nearly 200 artisans in Nicaragua and Guatemala, most of whom make colorful hand-woven bracelets, or "pulseras" in Spanish. The project then creates a market for their artwork by partnering with schools across the U.S.

Pulseras will be sold for \$5 here in our school, and the proceeds will be invested in a wide range of social impact programs in Nicaragua & Guatemala.

We hope this will be a highlight of the school year as students engage with the beauty of Latin American culture while lending support to these skilled artisans and their communities!

Bracelets can be purchased before school in the high school lobby on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

Madison Instrumental Music 2021-2022

Dear Parents of a child entering the 6th grade next fall,

In the first week of May during the school day, your child will attend a concert showcasing all of the musical opportunities available to them in string orchestra, band, and choir.

There is a short video that parents and students will receive showcasing the individual instruments.

The four string orchestra instruments are:

Violin, Viola, Cello, Bass

The Band Instruments

Flute, Clarinet, Alto Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Percussion

Baritone and Tuba-- These are low brass instruments. Students will often start on Trumpet or Trombone and switch to these instruments.

Percussion – there are a limited amount of percussionist we can enroll. Percussion is very competitive so it is possible that we may have to have an audition if there is a lot of interest. We can only have 2 to 4 percussionist per grade level.

Why Join a music ensemble at Madison?

- √ Improved concentration, coordination, self-discipline
- ✓ Current research suggests a correlation between instrumental music studies and higher standardized test scores
- ✓ Performing is a great learning experience and a way to share music with the community
- √ It is a wonderful outlet for young students to express his or her artistic ability
- √ Make new friends
- ✓ Helps build the appreciation of music
- ✓ Raise self-confidence, no one sits on the bench

Who can join?

Students entering the 6th grade for the 2020-21 school year who have the desire to learn how to make music. No advance musical training is required. The students will start from the very beginning learning how to hold the instrument and learning how to read music.

How do you rent or buy an instrument?

SHAR Music and Marshall Music offer programs where you can pay a small monthly fee to rent an instrument. Money that you put in rental fees will go toward the purchase of any instrument that they sell. These rental programs include maintenance and upkeep on the instrument being rented. If finances are an issue, we will work something out. We have several school instruments available for use if renting is not an option.

Once you sign up for Orchestra or Band, you will be contacted with more detailed information by the end of the year, and/or at the start of the school year on how to rent, buy or borrow an instrument.

Madison's Great Start Readiness preschool program is now accepting new students. Children who are turning four years old, but who are less than five years old by September 1 are eligible. Children must reside in Lenawee County and meet state criteria for enrollment.

The GSRP office will then send you an application through the mail.

Complete and send the application in the self-addressed envelope provided by GSRP, or deliver it to the GSRP at the Porter Center. (2946 Sutton Road, Adrian, MI 49221)

Someone from the GSRP office will contact you concerning your eligibility.

Please note that children are not placed into the program on a "first come first serve basis," but are prioritized by the family's income and number of other risk factors.


