Good Evening, Madison Families:

I hope that everyone has had a restful summer. We are excited to see all of our students back in the building for the start of the 2021-2022 school year. However, you and your family still have a few weeks left to enjoy before returning. Last year was a school year that looked very different than any other in the past. In partnership with our district families, we were able to stay open for face-to-face instruction, for a majority of last school year, due to the multitude of safety procedures and protocols that we put into place. That being said, I know that many families are anxious to know what the 2021-2022 school year will look like. Below, you will find a table of information addressing many key areas for the Madison School District. Please understand that there may be changes to this plan as different authoritative organizations establish new enforceable mandates or laws that change through the legislative process. If/when we are faced with such changes, we will communicate clearly and quickly in an effort to minimize disruption to our students, families, and staff.

**In the absence of any enforceable federal or state COVID restrictions or mask mandates, our plans for the 2021-2022 school year are as follows:**

Component	Madison School District Response
Masks	<p>Not required in school buildings or on campus. The voluntary wearing of masks at school is encouraged by state and federal health officials. The Madison School District will leave the choice to our families whether or not their child will wear a mask.</p> <p><i>As a district, we will respect everyone's personal choice in this area, understanding that there are varying tolerances, comfort levels, and circumstances affecting this decision.</i></p> <p>Required on public transportation, including school buses, per <a href="#">Federal Order</a></p>
Physical Distancing	Not required. However, the district will promote in areas where it is possible
Morning routines when entering the building	Similar morning routines, as utilized during the 2020-2021 school year, will continue as students enter the school building (specific routines and expectations will be shared by each building)
COVID-19 Screening	We encourage families to look for common COVID-19 symptoms prior to sending their students to school each day. <a href="#">Screener Tool</a>
Testing	Students, including athletes, will not be subject to any COVID-19 testing protocols

<b>COVID-19 Vaccination</b>	Not required. However, state and federal health officials do encourage the <u>COVID-19 vaccination</u> for all eligible individuals.
<b>Ventilation/HVAC</b>	Ventilation systems in buildings were upgraded during the 2020-2021 school year. Those upgrades and routine maintenance will continue during the 2021-2022 school year and beyond.
<b>Absences due to being sick/getting tested</b>	Staff and families are expected to use good judgment, stay home when they are sick, and report absences according to our attendance policies.
<b>Contact Tracing in Combination with Isolation &amp; Quarantine</b>	All contact tracing and isolation/quarantine communication and decisions will come directly from the Lenawee County Health Department.
<b>Cleaning &amp; Disinfection</b>	The Madison School District will continue to implement the protocols utilized during the 2020-2021 school year, using products approved by the CDC, to be effective against the COVID-19 virus.
<b>School Day</b>	As a district we will transition to a more "traditional" school day set up that allows a more normal flow of traffic between classes, intermittent use of lockers, unrestricted recesses, use of cafeterias, assemblies, field trips, class parties, and other opportunities to welcome guests back into our buildings.
<b>Technology</b>	All Madison School District students will be provided a 1:1 technology device for the school year.
<b>Learning Model Options</b>	Last year, The Madison School District provided families an opportunity to decide if they would like to participate in face-to-face learning or Virtual (100% online virtual learning). We will offer that option again for the 2021-2022 school year. However, this year the virtual content will not be created by Madison teachers. It will be created by a third party vendor and monitored by Madison staff members. A second communication will be sent out later this week containing more information on the virtual option and a survey that will need to be completed if you are planning on choosing that option for your family.

Dear Madison Middle School Families,

This summer all Lenawee County Schools are transitioning from the Student Information System (SIS), Eschool, to a new SIS called Infinite Campus. As a result, the Home Access Center is not available to students and families at this time. Middle school students may pick up their schedule and locker assignment beginning Friday, August 20th through Thursday, August 26th from 8:30am – 3:30pm. Crowd levels will be smaller during this time. In addition, schedules and locker assignments can be picked up at an Open House on Tuesday, August 24th from 5:30pm – 7:00pm, as well as the first day of school.

Each student will be assigned a laptop the first day of school. An annual Technology and Textbook Fee of \$25 will be assessed to all students grades 6-12 before they are assigned a device or textbook. This fee can be paid using your MySchoolBucks account. Questions regarding MySchoolBucks can be directed to Dawn Opsal in Central Office at [dawn.opsal@madisonk12.us](mailto:dawn.opsal@madisonk12.us).

This fee will cover the following:

- Normal textbook/library book wear and tear
- Routine device maintenance (battery and hardware replacement, etc.)
- A maximum of two accidental device damage repairs (cracked screen, broken keys, etc.)

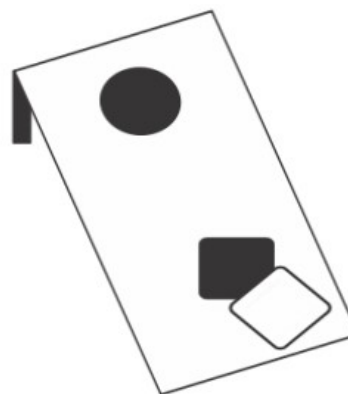
