



Madison HS Students Aiden Mahony, Halle Horwath, Dominic Regalado, and Kiersten Brackelman were all recognized for their essay entries into this year's VFW Voice of Democracy contest. The theme of this year's essay was "America: Where Do We Go From Here?" for high school students.

Mahony was selected as the best essay in the contest and was presented a \$100 check from the VFW during a ceremony on January 15th.

"I just thought of some things that could be considered a negative (in the country) and how we can fix them and how we can turn those into a positive in an easy way," Mahony said. Madison HS Earns Female Diversity Award

Madison High School has earned the College Board's AP® Computer Science Female Diversity Award for expanding young women's access to AP Computer Science Principles (CSP). Our school is one of only 760 schools across the United States to be recognized for achieving this important result in AP CSP.

Calculator Buying Guide

Students entering sixth grade will use the TI-34 II Explorer Plus Calculators. Seventh grade students will use the TI-84 Silver Plus Graphing Calculators. Eighth grade students will use the TI-84 Silver Plus and the TI-Nspire. High School students will use the Inspire and Nspire CX.

Buying a TI-84 graphing calculator or Nspire is a great investment. Calculators are provided for students to use in the classroom. However, students will benefit from having their own calculator to use at home. Please check with your child's teacher for the specific calculator model.


