Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

Madison Middle School will administer the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT) on April 13th to students in the 8th grade. This date has been set by CollegeBoard and the Michigan Department of Education. The PSAT 8/9 is the first test in the SAT Suite of Assessments. Tightly aligned with the SAT and the PSAT/NMSQT, it establishes a baseline for college and career readiness. Testing will take place in the middle school gymnasium from 7:50am - 11:00 a.m.

Virtual students are encouraged to take the PSAT 8 with their classmates and are asked to register with the office for planning purposes.

The PSAT 8 will support all students with personalized feedback about his/her academic strengths and weaknesses, helping each student to prepare for success in college and careers. Parents and Educators will have an early opportunity to:

- Measure and follow student performance
- Ensure students are on target to achieve college and career readiness
- Pinpoint areas for development

Research indicates that students who take the PSAT are more likely to score higher on the SAT during their junior year of high school. This statistic is due in part to the familiarity of taking a timed, high-stakes test. Furthermore, every student that takes the PSAT 8 is given access to multiple online resources that provide free personalized SAT preparation along with college and career planning tools. These resources include:

- A PSAT 8/9 score report that includes detailed answer explanations
- A personalized study plan when the student links his/her PSAT 8/9 results to the Khan Academy site.

Parents, we appreciate your support of this assessment as your student continues on his/her journey through middle school, high school, and beyond. In preparation for this assessment, please discuss this opportunity with your child and encourage him/her to give their best effort. It is important to remember that testing is a part of learning. State assessment results do not impact student grades. These assessments are designed to provide information surrounding student knowledge, preparing for college and career readiness.

Buying a TI-84 graphing calculator or Nspire is a great investment. Calculators are provided for students to use in the classroom. However, students will benefit from having their own calculator to use at home. Please check with your child's teacher for the specific calculator model.
