



Madison Middle School Music 2022-2023

Dear Parents of a child entering the 6th grade next fall,

In the last part of May during the school day, your child will attend a concert showcasing all of the musical opportunities available to them in string orchestra, band, and choir.

The four string orchestra instruments are:

Violin, Viola, Cello, Bass

The band instruments:

Flute, Clarinet, Alto Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Percussion

Baritone and Tuba-- These are low brass instruments. Students will often start on Trumpet or Trombone and switch to these instruments.

Percussion – there are a limited amount of percussionist we can enroll. Percussion is very competitive so it is possible that we may have to have an audition if there is a lot of interest. We can only have 2 to 4 percussionist per grade level.

Why join a music ensemble at Madison?

- ✓ Improved concentration, coordination, self-discipline
- ✓ Current research suggests a correlation between instrumental music studies and higher standardized test scores
- Performing is a great learning experience and a way to share music with the community
- ✓ It is a wonderful outlet for young students to express his or her artistic ability
- √ Make new friends
- √ Helps build the appreciation of music
- √ Raise self-confidence, no one sits on the bench

Who can join?

Students entering the 6th grade for the 2022-23 school year who have the desire to learn how to make music. No advance musical training is required. The students will start from the very beginning learning how to hold the instrument and learning how to read music.

How do you rent or buy an instrument?

SHAR Music and Marshall Music offer programs where you can pay a small monthly fee to rent an instrument. Money that you put in rental fees will go toward the purchase of any instrument that they sell. These rental programs include maintenance and upkeep on the instrument being rented. If finances are an issue, we will work something out. We have several school instruments available for use if renting is not an option.

Once you sign up for Orchestra or Band, you will be contacted with more detailed information by the end of the year, and/or at the start of the school year on how to rent, buy or borrow an instrument.





Calculator Buying Guide

Students entering sixth grade will use the TI-34 II Explorer Plus Calculators. Seventh grade students will use the TI-84 Silver Plus Graphing Calculators. Eighth grade students will use the TI-84 Silver Plus and the TI-Nspire. High School students will use the Inspire and Nspire CX.

Buying a TI-84 graphing calculator or Nspire is a great investment. Calculators are provided for students to use in the classroom. However, students will benefit from having their own calculator to use at home. Please check with your child's teacher for the specific calculator model.
